BURSARIES

Aspeling Scholar Bursaries

As part of our commitment to transformation and educational equity, Aspeling High School offers **AHS Scholar Bursaries** to disadvantaged single parent's learners with term and conditions. These bursaries are awarded based on **financial need and the learner's potential**, which can be further developed and nurtured through our school's academic, cultural, and character-building programmes.

Discount Scholar bursaries may be considered in the following areas:

- Academic ability
- Single-parent or guardian households with full-time employment
- Cultural or artistic talent
- All-round ability and good character

Important: *This discounted bursaries for parents with low income (must be full time employed)*

Eligible learners must demonstrate **integrity, respect, diligence, and perseverance**, and show a willingness to live out the core values of the school.

Levels of Support Offered by Donors:

- 15% of tuition fees
- 25% of tuition fees
- 50% of tuition fees
- 65% of tuition fees

These bursaries provide **partial financial assistance** to help families cover the cost of quality education at Aspeling High.

Compassionate Bursaries

Compassionate bursaries are available to **current learners at AHS** whose parents or guardians are, due to unforeseen and temporary circumstances, unable to meet school fees.

Compassionate bursaries is a temporary 3 (Three) months discount on monthly fees.

Applications can be submitted to the Head Office using the appropriate form, which is available from the Admissions Secretary.

Donor (Sponsorship) Bursaries

Each year, a limited number of **donor bursaries** are awarded to selected learners who require **financial support**. These bursaries are made possible through the generosity of individuals and organisations committed to supporting education.

Profile of the learner will be presented to the donors to select a candidate for the Donor bursaries list.

How to Apply

Aspeling High School: Bursary & Discount Bursary Application Requirements

We are committed to supporting families who demonstrate financial need and a commitment to academic or personal growth. Below are the requirements to apply for either our **Scholar Bursaries** or **Discount Bursaries**:

General Requirements:

- Complete the **Bursary Application Form (provided at our school)**
- Submit a **motivation letter** from the parent/guardian
- Provide the **latest school report** of the learner
- Submit **proof of income** (latest 3-month payslips, 3 months bank statements, or 6 months if self-employed)
- Discount Bursaries are only for employed Single parent/s, divorce with supporting documents or guardians court order.
- Provide a **certified copy of ID** (parent/guardian and learner)
- Demonstrate good **discipline and character references**
- **Donor Bursaries is only for our current learners at AHS.**
- Be willing to participate in a **bursary review interview**
- **Credit check might be considered**

All bursary applications are reviewed by the **Scholarships and Bursaries Committee**. Aspeling High School will inform applicants of the level of support that can be offered, based on eligibility and alignment with the selection criteria.
